The Military Banner Program salutes our brave men and women who are currently serving and those who have served in the military by creating and displaying a 24" x 36" military banner to be exhibited on the Route 88 stretch of Bethel Park between Memorial Day and Veterans' Day for years to come.

This program includes:

- 1) 1 - 24" x 36" Military Banner to be displayed by the borough along Route 88
- 2) 1 - 24" x 36" Military Banner or Two 12" x 18" banners for personal display
- 3) 1 – Bracket to hold the banner while displayed along Route 88
- 4) 1 – Mounting hardware to hang the bracket on a telephone pole
- 5) Web presence on the Bethel Park and American Legion websites

The one-time cost to join the program is \$80.
