This program includes:

- 1) 1 - 24" x 36" (or 18" X 30" - depending on location) Military Banners to be displayed by the borough
- 2) Optional - 12" x 18" Replica Banner for personal display (\$20 each)
- 3) 1 – Mounting hardware to hold the banners while on public display
- 4) Web presence on the Bellevue Military Tribute website
