Military Banners will be displayed on sustainable utility poles along Route 58 and surrounding streets (as needed). Each banner will be  $24'' \times 36''$  ( $2' \times 3'$ ). The veteran's picture will be displayed on both sides of the banner along with name, rank, branch of military and era of service. The banners will be displayed prior to Memorial Day and will be removed after Veterans Day for winter storage.

**Banner and package** - \$135.00: 1- 24"x36" banner for display. One 12"x18" yard banner for personal use. The fee includes mounting hardware and maintenance for hanging the banners in Foxburg. The banner will also be featured on the Military Tribute Website. (www.TroopBanners.com/Foxburg)

After Veterans Day the display banner can be returned to the purchaser or stored at the Foxburg Community Building. Depending upon the response and availability, any banner in good condition may be rehung during future campaigns for a fee of \$10.00 (to be paid prior to November 1st of the prior year).

**Veteran Criteria** includes those on active duty in any armed service, an honorably discharged veteran or one who gave their life serving in the armed service. They must have lived or be living in the Foxburg or surrounding (16036) area. Due to the vast amount of ribbons & medals that have been awarded over the years - Only Medals of Valor will be added to the banners. Proof must be submitted with the application to be included on the banner.

**Process**: Applications will be accepted through March 31st and processed in the order received. No application for display in the current year will be accepted after March 31st. The application must include the veteran's name, rank, military branch and era of service. Please submit a military photo, if possible. (Photo will be returned). If not available, a military ribbon or symbol will be used. Or send a scanned photo (a high quality scan at 600dpi) to banners@troopbanners.com.
