

Mount Washington Military Banner Program

Mount Washington has always taken great pride in the men and women who have served our country in its times of need. Now we'd like to take this opportunity to invite you to help us honor your friends and family who have served our great country.

We are preparing to salute military veterans from the 15211 zip code or members of VFW Post 5111 by displaying their photo on a 24" x 36" vinyl banner to be exhibited on various streets on the mount.

Program Details

Mount Washington VFW Post 5111 has joined the Military Banner Program where the residents of Mount Washington can have their family's Military Service members publicly displayed on street poles. (Length of time on poles and street locations to be determined. Our goal is a multi-year posting on heavily traveled streets of Mt. Washington.)

The cost is \$200 per veteran and includes:

- (1) 24" x 36" single-sided Military Banner for public display;
- Bracket and mounting hardware to hang your banner on the pole;
- Partial hanging cost and (2) 12" x 18" yard/replica banners for you to keep;
- Additional 12" x 18" Yard banners can be ordered with the order for \$10 each, \$20 after the initial
- Web presence on the TroopBanners.com website: indexed and stored online for generations to come!

- If your public displayed banner is damaged, destroyed, or weather worn, you may replace it at the current single banner cost.

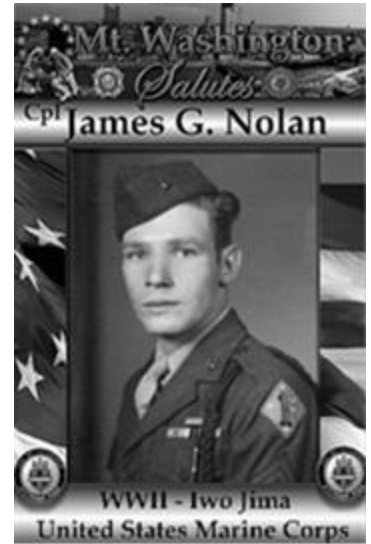

Once the application and photo is received and the banner draft is completed an email will automatically be sent out to the committee and the family submitting the application through the email address listed on the application. At times these email notices have gone into the recipients spam folders. If you don't receive an email within a few days of submission your banner draft can be viewed and checked on the <https://troopbanners.com/mtwashington/> website, if the applicant does reply with any required changes, the finalized banners will go to print after the 5 day grace period, no changes can be made after this point.

This grace period is provided to the applicant to check for and correct any typo's that may be shown on the banner draft before they go to print.

Banners needing replaced due to weather, wear or other are the responsibility of the submitting family.
